Another year has passed and the 99<sup>th</sup> Bomb Group Historical Society (BGHS) has had a very successful year. This has included a number of accomplishments of which a few are highlighted below:

*The B-17 Flying Fortress Historical Calendar* - For the third straight year we have made the "The B-17 Flying Fortress Historical Calendar" available to our members at a reduced cost, and for 2007 we are planning to have the calendar totally dedicated to the 99<sup>th</sup> BG using the photos provided to us by our members or through other public sources such as the National Archives.

*The Diamondbacks – The History of the*  $99^{th}$  *Bomb Group (H)* - We were able to work with Turner Publishing and succeeded in having them print an additional 100 copies of "The Diamondbacks – The History of the  $99^{th}$  Bomb Group (H)" to fill back orders for our membership and provide for future donations to Libraries and other locations where the  $99^{th}$  BG history can be perpetuated.

Requests for 99<sup>th</sup> BG information from overseas average about one or two requests per month and come primarily from Italy, Poland, Germany and the areas formerly known as Yugoslavia and Hungary.

99<sup>th</sup> Bomb Group Website – We all are very pleased that Janet Stoddard (her father was a ball turret gunner in the 347th BS, from Nov 1944 to the end of the war) volunteered to reestablish the 99<sup>th</sup> BG website and serve as the Webmaster for the site originally setup by Ford Lauer III. The 99<sup>th</sup> BG Website was back up and running prior to the October 2005 Annual Reunion and I hope that each of you who have computer access will visit the site and provide us with your feedback as to how we might continue to improve upon the website.
